Why?

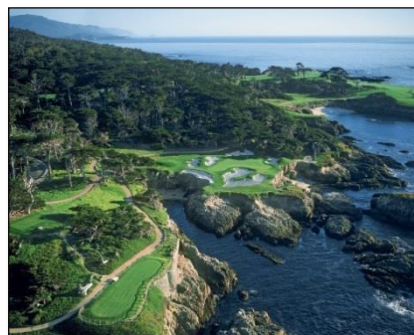
It is a true championship course – just make sure you have a caddie telling you where to hit it!
